Zineswap aims to be a resource through which people can swap their zines with one-another. It also aims to become a vast archive of contemporary self-publishing, existing as both an online catalogue and a biannual exhibition. You can get involved. Send us your zines and receive other peoples in return. This is a completely free, non-profit service, all you need to do is pay for the postage and allow us to keep two of your zines for an archive.

The swap:

Before you start, read the FAQ on the website.

1. Fill out the form.
2. Highlight 2 spreads in your publication using a post-it or bookmark. These will be used for the archive (see across).
3. Put your zines, the form, and a self-addressed stamped envelope into a package and mail it to us. Make sure your self-addressed envelope is stamped to the same value as the package you send to us. (international participants see FAQ on website)
4. You'll receive items selected on your behalf in the post within a week or so.

We will keep 2 items for the archive. Depending on the amount of items in our stock, we may have to issue credits.

The archive:

We will list your publications in the online catalogue, complete with the selected images and the information provided on the form. This catalogue will be accessible to all. We aim to exhibit this growing archive twice a year in a suitable venue in which people may view the items up close. We see this exhibition taking the shape of a temporary library in which people may request the publications and sit down to read them.

We welcome all zines, in every conceivable shape and form.
